# Joint Press Conference for L.A. International Earthquake Conference, Great Southern California ShakeOut and Golden Guardian to Kick Off a Week of Earthquake Activities

The L.A. International Earthquake Conference, Great Southern California ShakeOut and Golden Guardian will hold a joint press conference to kick off a week of activities related to earthquake preparedness, training, response, research, policy and public outreach, on Wednesday, Nov. 13, at 12:00 pm at the Omni Hotel in Downtown L.A.

This will be a final media briefing before the ShakeOut Drill, the largest earthquake drill in U.S. history, which begins at 10:00 am Thursday, Nov. 13 with over 5.1 million people participating. The ShakeOut and the Golden Guardian emergency response exercise are based upon the 7.8 San Andreas Fault earthquake scenario.

The press conference will also discuss the events and expected outcomes of the L.A. International Earthquake Conference, offer 3-D animations illustrating the ShakeOut Drill scenario which the media can use in news stories, and will explain the "Get Ready Rally," a large rally on Friday, Nov. 14, to help raise public awareness and participation in earthquake preparedness.
